 - Executive Session: Pursuant to G.L. c. 30A, § 21(a)(8): To consider or interview applicants for employment by a preliminary screening committee, if the Chair declares that an open meeting will have a detrimental effect in obtaining qualified applicants. (This shall not apply to any meeting regarding applicants who have passed a prior preliminary screening.) A vote regarding whether to go into executive session is expected; and votes may occur during the executive session.
 - Executive Session: pursuant to G.L. c. 30A, §21(a)(3) to discuss strategy relating to pending litigation known as, Granville v. Tysz et al., (Granville ZBA and Town of Granville), Massachusetts Housing Court, 22H79SP000577, if the Chair declares that an open meeting may have a detrimental effect on the litigating position of the Board. A vote regarding whether to go into executive session is expected; and votes may occur during the executive session. The Board will not return to open session after the executive session.
