## Watch out for yet another new email scam

Today's Sound Off is about a new cam going around, so beware.

Dear Heloise: There is a new scam oing around through email, no matter which carrier you use.
The scam starts with: "I am the repreentative of the custorer supportcenter ..." They claim to have received com plaints about your email account sending out malware and viruses. They will ell you there were thousands of spam mails sent from your account and hreaten to delete your account within 48 hours if you don't respond immeditely. Then they'll tell you to install an antivirus software and that they will elect the best one for you.
Below this, there will be a box that they want you to click that reads: "Scan or viruses." Don't click on that box.
This is nothing more than a scam and an effort to steal as much of your personal information as they can. If they get into your computer, they'll try to access your banking information and your credit and debit card information. They can also disrupt your computer service and cause other problems.

If you look at the top of the email, you'll see a return email address that is clearly not from your carrier. That's your first clue this is a scam. ader, via email
